

Guidance: Amending a Patient Medical Record

Amending a Patient Medical Record

Under the HIPAA Privacy Regulation, patients have the right to request that their medical record information be amended if they believe there is an error. Individuals may request an amendment by completing the Request for Amendment of PHI form and submitting it to the Risk Management and Patient Safety Office. Patients must include a reason to support the amendment request. Upon review of the request with all appropriate clinical and administrative personnel, the patient will be notified whether the request has been accepted or denied.
